Privacy Policy

INTRODUCTION

The Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation (registered charity no. 312407, also known as Bluecoat Trust) takes the privacy and security of your data extremely seriously.

This privacy policy sets out how the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation processes personal data (that is, information by which an individual can be identified) collected by us in the course of our lawful activities, and explains our obligations and your rights under the Data Protection Act 1998 and any subsequent UK legislation and regulations ('Data Protection laws'). This policy has been put in place to protect your rights under the Data Protection laws, and it is important that you understand what we will do with your data and are happy with this.

References to the processing of information includes the collection, use, storage and protection of data.

The Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation is the 'data controller' for the purposes of this policy, and the policy extends to its staff, trustees, volunteers and anyone else processing data on our behalf from time to time.

The Foundation is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Any personal data collected by the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation will only be processed in accordance with this privacy policy.

LEGAL BASIS

Organisations are permitted to process data if they have a legal basis for doing so. The Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation processes data on the basis that:

- Express and informed consent has been given by the person whose data is being processed; and/or
- The Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation has a legitimate interest to process data; and/or
- There is a legal obligation on the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation to process data.

Where the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation is relying solely on consent as the basis for processing data, we are required to obtain your explicit consent and you can modify or withdraw this consent at any time by notifying us in writing, however Trustees will not be able to consider applications for awards if consent is withdrawn.

The Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation may change this policy from time to time and any such changes will be published on our webpage. Notwithstanding any change to this policy, we will continue to process your personal data in accordance with your rights and our obligations in law.

This policy is effective from 1st of April 2018.

WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?

We collect data necessary for the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation to pursue its stated charitable objectives, the provision of awards to young people in the London Borough of Greenwich. Personal data is collected and processed so that Trustees can consider fully applications for awards.

WHAT DO WE DO WITH THE DATA WE PROCESS?

The Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation uses the data collected solely for the purpose of Trustees considering the eligibility of applicants to receive an award from the Foundation. Data may be processed and viewed by staff, trustees and volunteers in the course of this process (all of whom work in accordance with this privacy policy) and will be retained only for as long as is reasonable and permissible in law. You, as the data subject, may request deletion of your data at any time in writing, subject to any overriding legal requirement for its retention.

YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO YOUR PERSONAL DATA

You may request details of personal information which we hold about you. Any such request must be submitted in writing. You may choose to restrict the collection or use of your personal information, but this may mean that Trustees will be unable to consider your application for an award.

You may, at any time, change your mind about what information we hold about you, or if we continue to hold it at all, subject to any legal obligation on the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation to retain data.

You are responsible for the accuracy of data you have provided to the Greenwich Blue Coat Foundation . If you believe that any information we are holding on you is incorrect or incomplete, please write to us as soon as possible. We will correct promptly any information found to be incorrect.

We may use your personal information to obtain references from referees you have nominated. We will not share data with any other third parties.
